TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By participating in the raffle, entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

Tickets

Price per ticket is \$20 - limited to a maximum of 1000 tickets.

Entry requirements

Raffle entry is by purchase of a ticket only. This raffle is open to New Zealand Residents only. The organiser (Susan Stephen of the Martinborough Life Flight Fundraising Group) is excluded from winning. By entering the draw, winners confirm their agreement to have their name published in Life Flight communication channels.
